Follow The Flow Answer Key

Paragraph 1

Maria had to prepare **for** her final exams. She decided to focus **on** her weak subjects, especially science. Her teacher advised her to pay close attention **to** the instructions and not complain **about** the workload. Maria promised to keep **to** her goals and make progress every day.

Paragraph 2

James arrived late to the meeting and had to apologize **to** his manager. He explained that he had depended **on** the train schedule, but there was a delay. The manager told him to take responsibility **for** his time management and to make an effort to improve. James promised to give **of** his best in the future.

Paragraph 3

The soccer team succeeded **in** winning the championship last weekend. Their coach insisted **on** daily practice before the big match. During the final, the players concentrated **on** their strategy and did not break **from** their promise to work together. In the end, the crowd decided to give **to** the team a standing ovation.

Teacher Notes

- **Focus skill:** Colligation emphasizes *how verbs demand certain prepositions or structures* (e.g., *depend on, succeed in, apologize to*).
- **Word Bank Tip:** Some items are included as distractors (*make, keep, etc.*) to test judgment.
- **Extension idea:** After filling gaps, ask students to underline the verb and circle the *partner word/preposition* in each correct pairing.
- **Differentiation:** Stronger students can replace colligations with synonyms (*focus on* → *concentrate on*) to expand their repertoire.
