Sample Combined Sentences (answers may vary slightly if colligation is correct)

Teacher Notes

- **Purpose:** This activity practices combining ideas smoothly while reinforcing colligation patterns (*insist on, succeed in, complain about*).
- **Key teaching point:** Students learn that colligation isn't just memorizing a pair, but **using it to connect ideas naturally**.
- **Flexibility:** Allow creativity in subjects and details as long as the core colligation is accurate.
- **Extension idea:** After combining, ask students to highlight the **verb/preposition/noun** partnership in each final sentence.
