Sample responses:

#### Flow Chart

- 1. Effect: Explorers reach the Americas and claim land for their countries
- 2. Cause: Explorers want to stay and create new communities
- 3. Effect: Indigenous peoples lose land, resources, and face forced changes to their way of life
- 4. Effect (or next consequence): Violence, wars, and long-term tension continue between groups

## **Analysis Questions**

- 1. Europeans explored to gain wealth, expand trade, spread religion, and increase their empires.
- 2. European settlement took land, disrupted traditional ways of life, and led to disease and conflict.
- 3. Answers will vary. Examples:
  - o King Philip's War was caused by colonists taking more land and forcing English laws on Indigenous people.
  - The Powhatan Wars began when English settlers demanded food and land, leading to battles with Native groups.
