Differentiation Tips

- Support:
 - o Provide a word bank with example concepts (volunteering, elections, religious freedom, entrepreneurship)
 - o Offer sentence starters such as "Today, people show hard work by..."
- Challenge:
 - o Ask students to include historical evidence from a specific colony
 - Convert journal responses into a short persuasive essay about the most important colonial value today

Engagement Strategies

- Small group share: Which value do we see most in our school community?
- Class chart: students add sticky notes with examples under each value category
- Encourage respectful discussion of differing ideas or beliefs

Extension Opportunities

- Research how one value appears in a major U.S. document (Declaration of Independence, Constitution, Bill of Rights)
- Create posters that illustrate each colonial value in both past and present contexts
- Compare colonial values with values of another culture or period in history
