Teacher's Guide

Differentiation Tips

- **Support:**
 - Provide a small picture next to each job or tool/role for visual learners
 - Offer a shorter explanation for each role and read aloud as needed
- **Challenge:**
 - Have students write a short paragraph comparing two jobs
 - Ask students to list tools each profession would need

Engagement Strategies

- Act out charades of different colonial jobs
- Pass around replicas or images of tools (e.g., horseshoe, candle mold)
- Create a "Help Wanted in the Colonies" job board

Extension Ideas

- Students research one colonial occupation and make a mini poster or flyer
- Compare colonial jobs to modern jobs (e.g., blacksmith → metalworker or mechanic)
- Write a diary entry from a worker's perspective in a specific colony region
