Teacher's Guide

- Review the meaning of the most common prefixes first: **re-** means again, **un-** means not, **pre-** means before, and **dis-** means opposite or apart.
- Encourage students to use context clues in each sentence before looking at the answer choices.
- For differentiation, offer a visual chart showing each prefix with picture-supported example words.
- For students needing more support, read the sentences aloud and discuss what makes each word choice correct or incorrect.
- For enrichment, have students create their own sentences using one or two prefixes from the worksheet.
- To boost engagement, allow partners to act out one completed sentence and have the class guess which prefix word fits.
