Teacher's Guide

- Review the meanings of key prefixes: **re-** means again, **un-** means not or reverse, **pre-** means before, **dis-** means opposite or apart.
- Discuss with students why the incorrect prefixed words in each sentence do not make sense.
- Have students read each corrected sentence aloud to reinforce proper usage and understanding.
- For differentiation, provide a word bank of correctly prefixed words for learners who need more structure.
- For engagement, let students create their own silly misused prefix sentences and exchange them with partners to fix.
- For extension, challenge advanced learners to explain how the meaning of the sentence changes when the correct prefix is added or removed.
