Suffix Fix-Up Answer Key

Corrected paragraph: The hikers moved with **excitement** as they began their climb up the trail. Teacher's Guide

- This worksheet strengthens students' ability to identify **incorrect or missing suffix forms** in context and correct them for clarity and accuracy.
- Provide support by reviewing common suffixes together and identifying which ones typically form nouns, adjectives, or adverbs.
- Encourage on-level learners to explain why each correction is necessary and how the suffix changes the meaning or part of speech.
- For extension, challenge students to write their own short paragraph with five suffix errors for a partner to correct or to highlight all suffix words in the corrected passage and sort them by suffix category.
