2. **True** – “Emma” and “Chicago” are proper nouns, correctly capitalized.
3. **False** – “statue of liberty” should be **Statue of Liberty** (proper noun not capitalized).
4. **False** – “dunkin donuts” should be **Dunkin’ Donuts** (proper noun not capitalized).
5. **True** – “Mrs. Brown” is a proper noun and correctly capitalized.
6. **False** – “saturday” should be **Saturday** (day of the week = proper noun).
7. **False** – “nile river” should be **Nile River** (proper noun not capitalized).
8. **False** – “cinema world” should be **Cinema World** (proper noun not capitalized).
9. **False** – “Diary of a wimpy kid” should be **Diary of a Wimpy Kid** (book title).
10. **True** – “Ava” (proper) and “robot” (common) are both correct.
11. **False** – “uncle George” should be **Uncle George** (title + name = proper noun).
12. **False** – “mona lisa” should be **Mona Lisa** (proper noun/art title).
13. **False** – “interstate 95” should be **Interstate 95** (proper noun).
14. **False** – “mars” should be **Mars** (name of a planet = proper noun).
15. **True** – “Sarah” and “Smoothie King” are both proper nouns, capitalized correctly.
