

Sort and Explain - Common vs. Proper Nouns Answer Key

1. **jennifer** – **Proper Noun**
➤ It is the name of a specific person, which makes it a proper noun and requires capitalization.
2. **pencil** – **Common Noun**
➤ This is a general item, not the name of a specific brand or model of pencil.
3. **mount everest** – **Proper Noun**
➤ This is the specific name of a mountain, so it's a proper noun and should be capitalized as **Mount Everest**.
4. **restaurant** – **Common Noun**
➤ This is a general place and does not refer to any particular restaurant by name.
5. **taco bell** – **Proper Noun**
➤ This is the name of a specific restaurant chain, so it is a proper noun and should be capitalized as **Taco Bell**.
6. **president lincoln** – **Proper Noun**
➤ This refers to a specific historical person, **President Lincoln**, so it is a proper noun.
7. **river** – **Common Noun**
➤ It's a general term for a type of natural feature, not the name of a particular river.
8. **amazon** – **Proper Noun**
➤ This is the name of a specific place (Amazon River or Rainforest) or company, both of which are proper nouns.
9. **holiday** – **Common Noun**
➤ This word describes a general type of day; it doesn't name a specific holiday.
10. **thanksgiving** – **Proper Noun**
➤ This is the name of a specific holiday and should be capitalized as **Thanksgiving**.
11. **book** – **Common Noun**
➤ This is a general item; it doesn't name any specific book.
12. **charlotte's web** – **Proper Noun**
➤ This is the title of a specific book, so it is a proper noun and should be capitalized as **Charlotte's Web**.
13. **city** – **Common Noun**
➤ This refers to a general place category, not the name of a specific city.
14. **boston** – **Proper Noun**
➤ This is the name of a specific city, so it is a proper noun and should be capitalized as **Boston**.
15. **mr. thomas** – **Proper Noun**
➤ This is a specific person's title and name, so it's a proper noun and should be written as **Mr. Thomas**.
