## **Forest Friends Answer Key**

Student answers will vary, but the following are examples of correct responses:

- 1. Both the red squirrel and the chipmunk gather food in the forest.
- 2. In the same way, they look for nuts, seeds, and other small foods.
- 3. One thing they share is that they live in forest habitats.
- 4. Unlike the red squirrel, the chipmunk spends most of its time on the forest floor.
- 5. However, the red squirrel is louder and more territorial.
- 6. On the other hand, the chipmunk stays quiet and hides more often.

## Teacher's Guide

- Use this worksheet after introducing **compare and contrast text structures** in Grades 3 to 5.
- Encourage students to underline key details in the passage before completing the stems.
- Offer sentence frames for support, such as "Both animals..." or "The chipmunk is different because...".
