Tool A: A compass is a navigation tool that shows direction. Hikers, sailors, and explorers use it to find their way when there are no clear signs or paths. It works by pointing toward Earth's magnetic north.

Tool B: A map is a visual tool that shows locations, routes, landforms, and distances. Travelers use it to understand where places are and how to move from one point to another. It helps users plan their path before they begin moving.
