Teacher's Guide

- Review common fraction-decimal equivalents before students begin ordering.
- Encourage students to convert all numbers to decimals to make comparisons easier.
- Provide a place value chart or number line for students who need visual support.
- Have pairs explain how they decided the order for one set before comparing answers.
- Challenge students to estimate the order first, then verify by converting.
- Extend the activity by having students create two new mixed sets for a classmate to order.
