Sample Responses

- 1. **Environmental problems:** Both describe threats to nature caused by human activity: pollution in Excerpt A, and climate change in Excerpt B.
- 2. **Causes differ:** Carson points to chemicals and pesticides, while the modern article highlights greenhouse gases and global warming.
- 3. **Best global issue:** Climate change, since it links pollution, government policy, and environmental activism.
- 4. **Importance**: Making connections helps students see literature as relevant, understand history's impact on today, and recognize their role in solving global problems.

Teacher Notes

- This worksheet bridges literature, informational text, and current events, reinforcing cross-text and real-world connections.
- Differentiation:
 - Provide struggling learners with a word bank (e.g., "pollution,"
 "climate change," "ecosystems," "government").
