## Scene Split

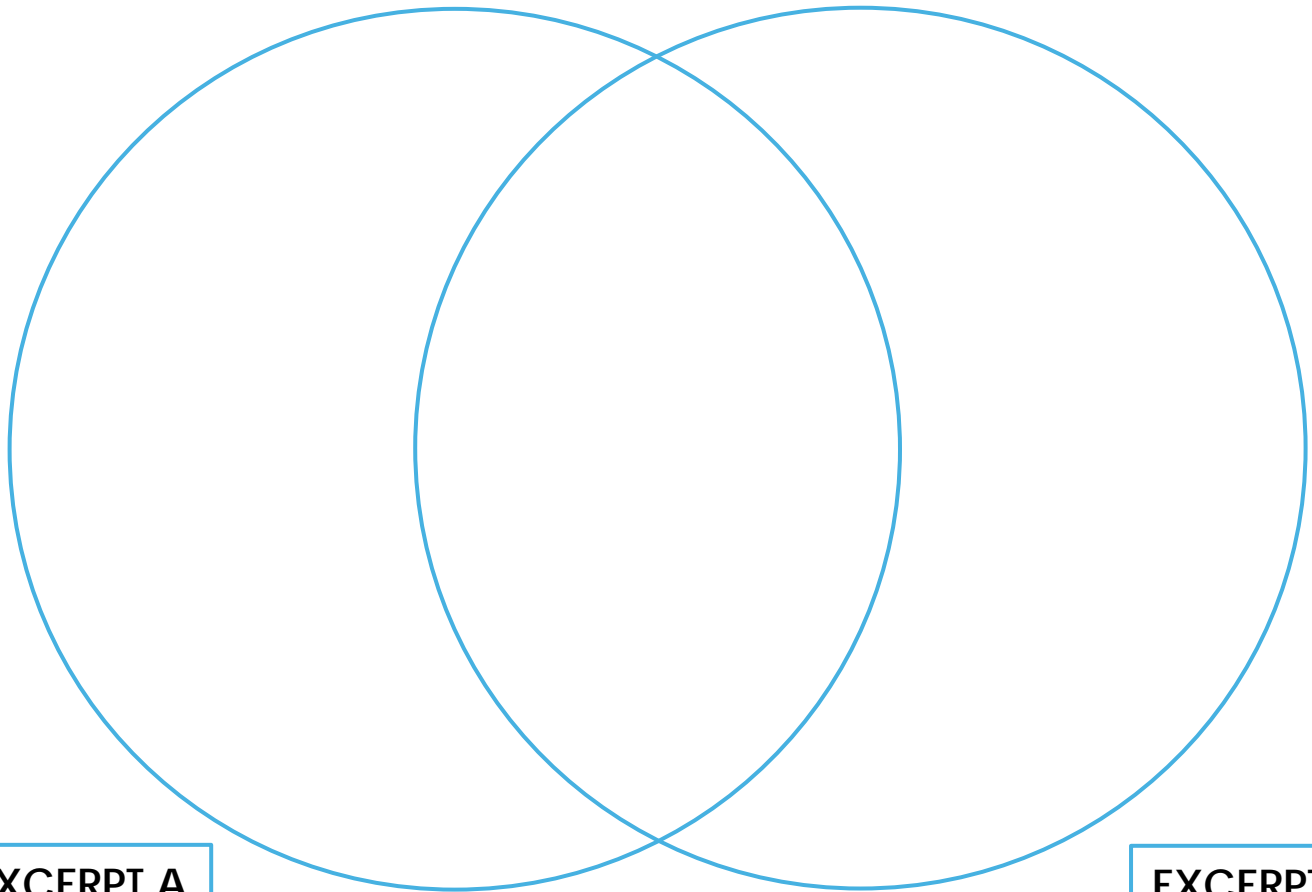
