

Right Clause Choice Answer Key

1. D. because it was raining.
→ I brought an umbrella **because it was raining.**
2. B. because the class was too noisy.
→ She couldn't hear the teacher **because the class was too noisy.**
3. C. until it got dark.
→ We stayed at the park **until it got dark.**
4. A. although he had practiced for weeks.
→ He was nervous **although he had practiced for weeks.**
5. A. because the clown made a silly face.
→ The baby laughed **because the clown made a silly face.**
6. C. if we don't leave now.
→ We will miss the bus **if we don't leave now.**
7. D. since the fireworks were so loud.
→ I stayed awake **since the fireworks were so loud.**
8. B. because it was snowing outside.
→ She wore her boots **because it was snowing outside.**

Teacher Guide / Notes

- This activity builds both **grammar accuracy** and **logical reasoning** by requiring students to evaluate meaning, not just mechanics.
- For extra challenge, ask students to **invent their own dependent clauses.**
- Encourage variety in subordinating conjunctions (*because, although, if, since, until, while*) to avoid repetition.
