## **Conjunction Expansion Answer Key**

Since answers will vary, below are **sample expansions** that demonstrate correct usage:

- 1. I like to read, but my sister prefers drawing.
- 2. We went to the park, and we played on the swings.
- 3. The dog barked **because** it heard a strange noise.
- 4. She stayed home, although her friends went shopping.
- 5. I was tired, **so** I went to bed early.
- 6. He wanted to play soccer, but it started raining.
- 7. The sun was shining, **yet** the air was still cold.
- 8. We can watch a movie, **or** we can play cards.
- 9. They studied all night, so they were ready for the test.
- 10. She wore a coat **since** it was cold outside.

## **Teacher Notes:**

- Encourage students to try different conjunctions for variety; most sentences could be expanded multiple ways.
- Point out the distinction between:
  - o Coordinating conjunctions (FANBOYS  $\rightarrow$  for, and, nor, but, or, yet, so).
  - Subordinating conjunctions (because, although, since, when, unless, etc.).
  - Correlative conjunctions (either...or, neither...nor, not only...but also, both...and).
- For advanced learners: Have them try to expand at least one sentence using a **correlative conjunction** (e.g., "She wore both a coat and a scarf because it was freezing").
