Since answers will vary, here are sample responses:

1. but

- I wanted to go to the beach, but it started to rain.
- He is young, but very responsible.
- We tried our best, **but** we didn't win the game.

2. because

- I stayed home because I was sick.
- She smiled because she won the prize.
- We were late because the bus broke down.

3. while

- I listened to music while I did my homework.
- While I understand your point, I still disagree.
- He cooked dinner while she set the table.

4. either...or

- You can have either pizza or pasta for lunch.
- I will call you either tonight or tomorrow morning.
- The prize will go to either Sam or Lily.

5. although

- Although it was raining, we still played soccer.
- Although she was nervous, she gave a great speech.
- Although he studied hard, he didn't pass the test.

Teacher Notes: Encourage students to vary sentence types (simple, compound, complex). For advanced learners, challenge them to use conjunctions at both the **beginning and middle** of sentences.
