Guide: "And" connects two similar ideas.

Guide: "Since" explains the reason for wearing a coat.

8. We were tired, although we kept walking.

Guide: "Although" shows that the action continued despite being tired.

9. You will not pass the test unless you study for it.

Guide: "Unless" sets a condition.

10. Sam practiced soccer every day, so he became a strong player.

Guide: "So" shows cause and effect.
