Sample Explanations (student answers may vary, but these capture the expected ideas):

- 1. Slim suggests attractiveness and health (positive), while skinny often suggests weakness or being underfed (negative).
- 2. Curious shows eagerness to learn (positive), but nosy suggests intruding into private matters (negative).
- 3. Economical means wisely managing money (positive), but cheap implies poor quality or stinginess (negative).
- 4. Childlike conveys innocence and wonder (positive), while childish conveys immaturity or silliness (negative).
- 5. Confident suggests self-assurance and ability (positive), while arrogant implies conceit or superiority (negative).
- 6. Home carries feelings of warmth, family, and belonging (positive/emotional), while house simply means a physical building (neutral).

Teacher Notes / Guide:

- This worksheet develops critical thinking about how subtle differences in word choice shape tone.
- Encourage students to support answers with **contextual examples** (e.g., "He looks slim in that suit" vs. "He looks skinny after being sick").
- Accept variation in answers, as long as reasoning is based on connotation
 vs. denotation.
