Correct Connotation Identifications:

- 1. Negative "Childish" implies immaturity, supported by the teacher's correction.
- 2. Positive "Childlike" suggests innocence and wonder, paired with fireworks.
- 3. Negative "Cheap" is used with broken lights and stains, which lowers quality.
- 4. Positive "Affordable" is paired with comfort and convenience.
- 5. Positive "Confident" is reinforced by respect and support.
- 6. Negative "Arrogant" is described as offensive and dismissive.
- 7. Positive "Unique" is praised as unforgettable.
- 8. Negative "Strange" is connected to whispering and unsettling feelings.

- This activity highlights how **context reveals connotation**, even if students don't know the word's dictionary meaning.
