## Sample Responses (students' answers may vary, but reasoning must be accurate):

- Skinny → Slim: "Slim" gives a more positive impression of health/attractiveness.
  - Skinny  $\rightarrow$  Scrawny: "Scrawny" makes the kitten sound weak or unhealthy.
- 2. Confident  $\rightarrow$  Self-assured: Positive tone, suggests capable and respectful. Confident  $\rightarrow$  Arrogant: Negative tone, suggests conceited or boastful.
- Cheap → Affordable: Positive/neutral tone, suggests good value.
  Cheap → Stingy: Negative tone, suggests meanness or unwillingness to spend.
- Childlike → Innocent: Positive tone, suggests wonder or purity.
  Childlike → Childish: Negative tone, suggests immaturity or silliness.
- Home → Dwelling: Neutral tone, just a factual description.
  Home → Residence: Neutral/formal tone, lacks warmth or emotional connection.

## Teacher Notes / Guide:

- The goal is to **see the impact of word swaps**, not just identify synonyms.
- Encourage students to use context clues to decide if a word feels positive, negative, or neutral.
- Accept alternative synonyms if students can clearly explain the connotation shift.
