Sample Definitions & Sentences

1. **Constitution** - The main set of laws that guides the United States.
Sentence: The Constitution explains how the government should work.
2. **Amendment** - A change or addition to the Constitution.
Sentence: The Bill of Rights includes the first ten amendments.
3. **Democracy** - A system where people vote to choose their leaders.
Sentence: The United States is a democracy where citizens have a voice.
4. **Rights** - Freedoms that belong to everyone.
Sentence: Freedom of speech is one of our basic rights.
5. **Responsibilities** - Duties citizens should do to help their community.
Sentence: Voting is an important responsibility.
6. **Government** - A group of people who make and enforce laws.
Sentence: The government helps keep order and protect citizens.
7. **Justice** - Fair treatment under the law.
Sentence: Courts make sure justice is served.
8. **Liberty** - The freedom to live and act without unfair limits.
