Teacher's Guide

- **Objective:** Build historical awareness and reading comprehension through identification of key Founding Fathers and their accomplishments.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - *For younger learners (Grades 3-4):* Read each fact aloud and show portraits of the Founders to aid visual memory.
 - *For advanced learners (Grade 5+):* Have students add one new fact for each Founder and assign it a new color.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Play "Fact Detective": students listen to clues and hold up red, blue, or green cards to show who the clue matches.
 - Create a classroom mural showing each Founder surrounded by illustrated facts.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Connect the Founders' work to the Constitution's principles (liberty, justice, equality).
 - Encourage students to write one short "Thank You" note to a Founder, explaining why his work still matters today.
