

Purpose Power-Up Answer Key

1. Write about recycling. Purpose: *persuade*

Context-Packed Rewrite: Write a persuasive paragraph encouraging students to recycle at school by explaining how it helps the planet and keeps the campus clean.

Why it fits: Adds audience (students), goal (encourage action), and reason (environmental impact).

2. Tell a story about an adventure. Purpose: *entertain*

Context-Packed Rewrite: Tell an exciting adventure story about two friends who get lost in the woods and discover something unexpected.

Why it fits: Adds characters, setting, and plot focus to engage readers.

3. Explain photosynthesis. Purpose: *teach*

Context-Packed Rewrite: Explain how photosynthesis works for 5th-grade science students, describing how sunlight, water, and carbon dioxide help plants make food.

Why it fits: Adds audience and content details for instruction.

4. Write about exercise. Purpose: *teach* or *persuade* (both acceptable)

Context-Packed Rewrite: Write an informative article explaining three ways regular exercise keeps the body healthy and strong.

Why it fits: Expands on the idea with structure (three ways) and specific focus (health benefits).

5. Tell about friendship. Purpose: *entertain*

Context-Packed Rewrite: Write a short story for kids about two classmates who learn the value of friendship after working together on a big project.

Why it fits: Turns a vague idea into a narrative with audience, characters, and situation.

6. Write a paragraph about homework. Purpose: *persuade*

Context-Packed Rewrite: Write a persuasive paragraph arguing that students should have less homework, giving at least two reasons that support your opinion.

Why it fits: Adds opinion, task type, and supporting structure.

7. Describe a famous person. Purpose: *teach*

Context-Packed Rewrite: Describe the life and achievements of Marie Curie in one informative paragraph for a science biography project.

Why it fits: Adds subject, context (science project), and focus (achievements).

8. Make a list of foods. Purpose: *teach*

Context-Packed Rewrite: Make a list of ten healthy breakfast foods and include one nutrition fact for each item.

Why it fits: Defines category, number, and expected detail type.

9. Write about kindness. Purpose: *persuade* or *entertain* (depending on rewrite)

Context-Packed Rewrite: Write a persuasive paragraph encouraging students to practice kindness at school, using examples of small actions that make a big difference.

Why it fits: Clarifies audience, goal, and examples.
