### Correctly Identified Conjunctions

#### Coordinating (Blue):

- so
- but (first occurrence)
- and (first occurrence)
- for
- and (second occurrence)
- but (second occurrence)

#### Subordinating (Green):

- because
- Although
- until
- since
- when

### Teacher Notes

- This activity blends **reading comprehension** with **grammar recognition**, forcing students to look closely at how conjunctions operate in real sentences.
- Encourage color-coding for visual learners (blue vs. green), but underlining with labels “C” and “S” also works if colors aren’t available.
- Remind students that **coordinating conjunctions join equal ideas**, while **subordinating conjunctions show dependence or condition**.
- Possible extension: Ask students to **write one more sentence** that uses both a coordinating and subordinating conjunction correctly.
