## Publication Probe Answer Key

**Source A - Academic Journal:** Credible. Peer-reviewed, written by experts, includes data and evidence.

**Source B - Newspaper:** Credible. Professional reporting, fact-checked, includes expert and public perspectives, though less detailed than academic research.

**Source C - Blog:** Less Credible. Personal opinion, anecdotal, no supporting data or peer review.

**Source D - Social Media Post:** Less Credible. Informal, no evidence, blurry photo and personal feeling only.

### Teacher Notes:

- Stress that credibility depends on **purpose, expertise, and evidence**.
- Academic journals are strongest for scientific accuracy.
- Newspapers balance accessibility and reliability.
- Blogs and social media may be useful for perspective or personal experience but are not reliable for factual accuracy.
