Source A - Academic Journal: Credible. Peer-reviewed, written by experts, includes data and evidence.

Source B - Newspaper: Credible. Professional reporting, fact-checked, includes expert and public perspectives, though less detailed than academic research.

Source C - Blog: Less Credible. Personal opinion, anecdotal, no supporting data or peer review.

Source D - Social Media Post: Less Credible. Informal, no evidence, blurry photo and personal feeling only.

Teacher Notes:

- Stress that credibility depends on purpose, expertise, and evidence.
- Academic journals are strongest for scientific accuracy.
- Newspapers balance accessibility and reliability.
- Blogs and social media may be useful for perspective or personal experience but are not reliable for factual accuracy.
