**Passage 1 - Trustworthy**. Written by an expert, peer-reviewed journal, evidence-based with data and references.

Passage 2 - Not Trustworthy. Anonymous author, sensational title, no data or credible evidence.

**Passage 3 - Trustworthy**. Government agency report, based on data and long-term research, transparent source.

## **Teacher Notes:**

- Reinforce that author expertise and evidence are central to credibility.
- Highlight how sensational language ("They Don't Want You to Know") is a red flag for low credibility.
- Discuss the difference between personal observation (useful but limited)
  and scientific research (systematic, verified, and more reliable).
