## **Timeliness Test Answer Key**

**Source A - 2010 magazine article**: Outdated. Predictions from 2010 are no longer reliable because EV popularity and technology have changed dramatically.

**Source B - 2019 government report**: Current (but aging). Still useful since infrastructure reports remain relevant for a few years, though newer updates would be stronger.

**Source C - 2023 peer-reviewed journal study**: Current. Very recent, written by experts, and directly tied to Naomi's research focus.

**Source D - 2007 blog post**: Outdated. Provides historical perspective but not credible for today's EV technology.

## **Teacher Notes:**

- Stress that recency depends on the topic: science/technology requires the newest research, while historical/literary sources may not.
- Highlight that "outdated" doesn't mean "useless" since older sources can provide background or historical context.
- Encourage students to consider both publication date and topic relevance when judging credibility.
