Proven Vs. Believed Answer Key

- 1. Fact Documented year and place of discovery.
- 2. Fact Physical description verified by observation.
- 3. Fact Specific quantity recorded by researchers.
- 4. Opinion "Most breathtaking flower" is a judgment, not provable.
- 5. Fact A belief held by communities can be reported as fact (though the belief itself is not measurable truth, the claim that people believe it is factual).
- 6. **Opinion** "Essential" and "represents beauty" are value-based judgments.

Teacher Notes:

- Clarify the subtlety in #5: while the belief in luck is a fact (people do believe it), whether the orchid actually brings luck is an opinion.
- Stress that facts are supported by observable evidence or reliable reporting, while opinions express values or judgments.
- Encourage students to justify their answers with phrases like "This can/cannot be proven" or "This is based on belief/feeling."
