

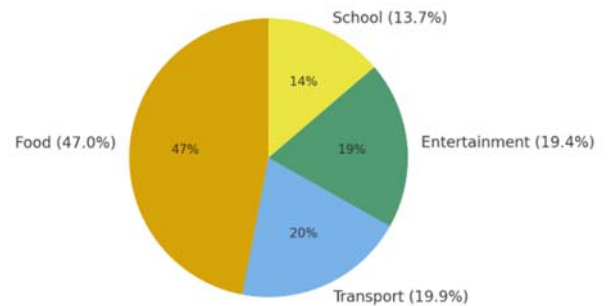

Multiple-Choice Answers

1. Which category had the highest average spending?
Answer: Food
2. Which category had the lowest average spending? **Answer:** School
3. About what percentage of total spending went to Food? **Answer:** 47%
4. Which two categories together make up about half of total spending?
Answer: Food + Transport (47% + 20% $\approx$ 67%) or Food + Entertainment (47% + 19% $\approx$ 66%) - either is acceptable.
5. What type of chart best shows how parts make up a whole?
Answer: Pie chart

Example Pie Chart Explanation - The pie chart shows that almost half of the students' spending went to **Food**, while **Transport** and **Entertainment** each made up about one-fifth. **School costs** were the smallest portion of the total.
