Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Vocabulary categorization and cultural literacy.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For younger learners, provide pictures of each word and have them sort visually.
 - For higher grades, ask students to add one more word to each category and explain their reasoning.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Play soft mariachi or traditional Día de los Muertos music during sorting.
 - Let students decorate their "word altar" pages with bright colors and patterns.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Invite students to write short sentences using one word from each category.
 - Connect the vocabulary to a mini discussion about how families honor loved ones around the world.
