Teacher's Guide

- **Skill Focus:** Reading comprehension, cultural awareness, and identifying main ideas.
- **Differentiation Tips:**
 - For younger or struggling readers, pre-teach key terms (*ofrenda*, *calavera*, *marigold*) with visuals.
 - For advanced readers, assign a brief paragraph response about how their own culture honors loved ones.
- **Engagement Ideas:**
 - Have students design a mini paper *ofrenda* for a fictional character or family pet.
 - Play traditional Day of the Dead music while reading to set the atmosphere.
- **Extension Activities:**
 - Students can research a similar remembrance holiday in another country (e.g., Japan's Obon or China's Qingming Festival).
