Teacher's Guide

Skill Focus: Helps students recognize positive versus negative peer influence and strengthens decision-making skills.

Differentiation Tips:

- Read scenarios aloud and discuss before students circle answers to support comprehension.
- Provide sentence stems such as "This is a good choice because..." for extended responses.

Engagement Ideas:

- Turn scenarios into quick role-plays where students act out both the YES and NO behaviors.
- Use color-coding (green for YES, red for NO) to visually reinforce choices.

Extension Activities:

- Have students create one new "peer pressure" scenario and write a positive way to respond.
- Build a class "Good Choice Wall" highlighting examples of standing up to peer pressure.
