## **Sample Thesis Statements:**

 Misguided Side: "Willy's pursuit of success was misguided because he clung to false ideas about popularity and wealth, ignoring reality and destroying his family in the process."

## Sample Evidence & Analysis:

- Quote: "Be liked and you will never want."
  - Shows Willy equates charm with success.
  - Supports misguided argument: he values image over hard work.
- Quote: "Nothing's planted. I don't have a thing in the ground."
  - o Shows futility of his life's efforts.
  - o Supports *misguided* argument: his dreams yield nothing real.
