Teacher's Guide

- Implementation tips
 - o Review addition, subtraction, and budgeting vocabulary before students begin.
 - o Encourage students to estimate totals before calculating exact amounts.
- Differentiation strategies
 - o Allow students who need support to use a calculator to check their work after solving manually.
 - o Challenge advanced students to find multiple correct answers for Question 8.
- Engagement ideas
 - o Have students pretend they are shopping for school supplies with a fixed budget.
 - o Let pairs compare different item combinations that stay within the budget.
- Extension activities
 - o Ask students to create a new shopping question using the same price list.
 - o Have students design their own mini store with decimal prices and write budgeting problems for classmates to solve.
