1) $2.75 + 3.6 = 6.35$ km

Teacher's Guide

- Review common measurement units such as kilometers, meters, kilograms, and liters before students begin.
- Encourage students to underline the numbers and units before choosing an operation.
- Remind students to include the correct unit in every answer.
- Support students by having them identify the operation before solving the problem.
- Pair students to compare strategies and explain why they chose addition, subtraction, multiplication, or division.
- Extend the activity by asking students to write one original measurement word problem using decimal values and exchange it with a partner to solve.
