

Kitchen Counts Answer Key

- 1) $1.25 \times 3 = 3.75$ L
- 2) $5.5 - 2.8 = 2.7$ L
- 3) $(0.75 \times 4) + 0.6 = 3.6$ kg
- 4) $1.2 \div 6 = 0.2$ kg
- 5) $4.5 \div 5 = 0.9$ L
- 6) $2.35 + 1.45 = 3.8$ cups
- 7) $9.5 - (1.6 \times 5) = 1.5$ kg
- 8) $0.85 \times 6 = 5.1$ L

Teacher's Guide

- Review when to use addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division in recipe situations before students begin.
- Encourage students to underline important numbers and identify the operation for each step before calculating.
- Support students by having them write an equation before solving each problem.
- Let pairs compare their equations and explain why they chose each operation.
- Challenge advanced students to create a new recipe problem that requires two operations.
- Extend the lesson by asking students to adjust one recipe to make twice as many servings or half as many servings and explain how the ingredient amounts change.
