From Plain To Wow Answer Key

(Sample answers - students' wording may vary as long as the sentences are clearly exclamatory with strong emotion.)

1. *The cake tastes good.* → **This cake tastes amazing!**
2. *The roller coaster goes fast.* → **That roller coaster goes so fast!**
3. *The fireworks are bright.* → **Wow, those fireworks are so bright!**
4. *The game was fun.* → **What a fun game that was!**
5. *The puppy is small.* → **How tiny this puppy is!**
6. *The movie was scary.* → **That movie was terrifying!**
7. *The snow is falling.* → **Look at the snow falling!**
8. *The race was close.* → **What a close race that was!**
9. *The music is loud.* → **This music is so loud!**
10. *The sunset is pretty.* → **What a beautiful sunset!**

Teacher Notes / Guide:

- Remind students that **exclamatory sentences express strong emotion** and always end with **!**.
- Encourage use of words like *what, how, so, wow*, to amplify tone.
- Accept variations as long as the **emotion is clear**. For example: "The fireworks are bright." → *The fireworks are dazzling!*
- **Extension idea:** Have students take one exclamation and "tone it down" back into a declarative, showing how punctuation changes mood.
