Inquiry Chain Answer Key

(Sample question chains - students' questions may vary as long as they stay interrogative and logically build on one another.)

1. The library has many books.

- Q1: Does the library have mystery books?
- Q2: Which mystery books are the most popular?
- Q3: Can I borrow more than one book at a time?

2. The team won the game.

- Q1: Did the team win by a big score?
- Q2: Who scored the most points in the game?
- Q3: Will the team play in the championship now?

3. The science experiment was successful.

- Q1: Why was the experiment successful?
- Q2: What steps made the experiment work?
- Q3: Can we try the experiment again tomorrow?

4. The store sells fresh fruit.

- Q1: What kinds of fresh fruit does the store sell?
- Q2: How much do the apples cost at the store?
- Q3: Is the fruit grown locally?

Teacher Notes / Guide:

- Emphasize that each new question should **logically follow** the one before.
- Encourage variety in interrogative words: *who, what, where, when, why, how*.
- Accept multiple variations as long as they remain **interrogative** and **connected**.
- **Extension idea:** Have students create their own declarative base sentence and build a 3-4 question chain with a partner.
