Exit Slip: Chart The Types Answer Key

(Sample responses - answers will vary. These are examples for teacher reference.)

| Declarative | Interrogative | Imperative | Exclamatory |
|-------------------------------------|--------------------------------------|-----------------------------|-------------------------------|
| The cat is sleeping on the chair. | Is the cat sleeping on the chair? | Please feed the cat. | What a cute cat that is! |
| We are reading a new book in class. | What book are we reading in class? | Open your book to page ten. | This book is so exciting! |
| The sun sets in the west. | Does the sun always set in the west? | Look at the sunset. | Wow, the sunset is beautiful! |

Teacher Notes / Guide:

- Emphasize that students should create **original examples**, not copy from the directions.
- Encourage variety: different topics (school, sports, animals, family, etc.) for each column.
- Accept reasonable variations as long as the **sentence type and punctuation are correct**.
- **Extension idea:** After filling in the boxes, have students **swap with a partner** and check each other's sentences for correct type and punctuation.
