Switch The Script Answer Key

1. *The bus leaves at eight o'clock.* → **Does the bus leave at eight o'clock?**
2. *Can you help me with my project?* → **You can help me with my project.**
3. *Close the window before the rain comes in.* → **What a storm we will have if the window stays open!**
4. *Wow, that was the best game of the season!* → **That was the best game of the season.**
5. *The dog is barking loudly in the yard.* → **Tell the dog to stop barking in the yard.**
6. *Please bring your homework to class tomorrow.* → **Students must bring their homework to class tomorrow.**
7. *Did you finish your book report already?* → **I can't believe you finished your book report already!**
8. *What an exciting trip this is!* → **Isn't this an exciting trip?**
9. *Sarah is painting a picture of the mountains.* → **Wow, Sarah is painting a picture of the mountains!**
10. *Don't forget to water the plants.* → **Did you remember to water the plants?**

Teacher Notes / Guide:

- Encourage students to notice how **punctuation shifts with sentence type**: period for declarative, question mark for interrogative, exclamation point for exclamatory.
- Remind them that **imperatives often drop the subject "you"** but still direct action.
- For creative practice, let students write one original sentence of each type, then have a partner convert them.
