Teacher Notes/Guide

- **Focus point:** Students should think about **singular vs. plural** and **near vs. far** when choosing the correct pronoun.
- **Scaffolding idea:** Model one example by underlining the repeated noun, then showing how to replace it with the correct pronoun.
- **Extension:** Ask students to highlight the **nouns** each demonstrative pronoun replaces (e.g., *cake, shoes, sound*).
- **Differentiation:** Challenge advanced students to create more complex combined sentences with adjectives or prepositional phrases.
