Teacher Notes/Guide

- **Extension:** Ask students to highlight the **nouns** each demonstrative pronoun replaces (e.g., cake, shoes, sound).
- **Differentiation:** Challenge advanced students to create more complex combined sentences with adjectives or prepositional phrases.
