Visualizing Demonstratives Answer Key

Note: Students' answers will vary. Below are examples that show accurate demonstrative pronoun use.

1. **This** cake looks delicious.
2. **These** balloons are so colorful.
3. **That** mountain looks enormous.
4. **These** shoes are mine.
5. **Those** birds are flying high.
6. **This** trophy makes me proud.
7. **Those** photographs remind me of the past.
8. **This** rainbow is beautiful.

Teacher Notes/Guide

- **Accept a range of answers** as long as the chosen pronoun matches singular/plural and near/far context.
- Encourage students to say their sentences out loud, pointing to something near or far, to reinforce meaning.
- As an extra challenge, ask students to rewrite one sentence by changing the pronoun (e.g., *These balloons are colorful* → *Those balloons are floating away*).
