Text Message Mystery

Skill Focus: Inferring character traits and feelings from how a character speaks (tone, word choice, responses)

Your Mission: You've been given access to a few private text message conversations between characters in a story. Your job? Act like a character detective and figure out what kind of people they are based only on what they say and how they say it.



Text Conversation 1: JAMIE and TYLER

Jamie: Ugh. Did you see our group project grade? 😩

Tyler: Yep. A minus. We're fine.

Jamie: Fine? That's practically failing. I KNEW we should've color-coded the slides.

Tyler: It's not that deep, Jamie. Chill.
