### Sensory Notes – What Can You Feel?

Below are prompts to help you explore your artifact. Imagine your hand is inside the bag. (In a live classroom, you could use real items. If working solo, imagine or choose a household item.)

### Object In the Bag

Answer these based on touch only:

- What shape is it?
- Is it hard, soft, or flexible?
- Does it have edges, corners, curves, or textures?
- Is it warm, cold, smooth, rough, sticky, or fuzzy?
- Does it move? Make a sound when shaken or squeezed?
- What do you think it's made of?
- What size is it compared to your hand?



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### The Description – Touch to Text

Now use your notes to write a **descriptive paragraph** (4–6 sentences). Pretend someone else has never seen or touched this object. Make it vivid and specific, using only the sense of **touch**—no guessing or naming it directly!
