

## Vivid Place Builder Answer Key

Answers will vary. A correct response should include:

- One or two adjectives for each noun.
- Adjectives that make sense for the place being described.
- Examples include:
  - beach: **sunny, quiet**
  - forest: **dark, lush**
  - city: **busy, bright**
  - mountain: **tall, rocky**
  - playground: **colorful, wide**
  - island: **tiny, tropical**
  - castle: **old, massive**
  - village: **small, peaceful**
  - river: **fast, sparkling**
  - space station: **shiny, floating**

### Teacher's Guide

- **Differentiation Tips:**
  - Provide a small adjective list for students who need support.
  - Allow students to talk through their ideas before writing.
  - Offer sentence frames for emerging writers such as: "It is a **word** place."
- **Engagement Ideas:**
  - Have students sketch each place after choosing adjectives.
  - Let students share their favorite expanded noun with a partner or the class.
  - Turn it into a guessing game where students read their adjectives and others guess the noun.
- **Extension Ideas:**
  - Ask students to use each expanded noun in a full descriptive sentence.
  - Invite students to select one place and write a short descriptive paragraph.
  - Create a classroom adjective wall with strong descriptive words students discover.
