• Sight: sparkly, bright

• Sound: crunchy, whisper, silent

• Smell: stinky, smoky, minty

• Taste: salty, sour, sweet, minty

• Touch: warm, smooth, bumpy, soft

(Note: Minty can be both smell and taste. Accept either or both.)

Teacher's Guide

- Use this worksheet to help young students build sensory vocabulary that supports descriptive writing skills.
- Encourage students to read each word aloud and act it out if helpful.
 Movement supports memory for Grades K to 2.
- Provide word cards for students who need hands-on sorting support.
- Offer extension by asking students to draw or write one object for each sense that matches the words they sorted.
- For additional challenge, prompt advanced students to create a short descriptive sentence using at least three sorted sensory words.
